

## **Forbidden Actions When Impure (Opinion 2)**

**The Forbidden Actions for a Person in the State of Minor Impurity (in need of Wuḍū’):**

1. Ṣalāh (prayer)
2. Ṭawāf (circumambulation of the ka’bah)
3. Touching or carrying the Qur’ān
4. Carrying the Qur’ān

\*It is not permissible to touch the Qurān, whether its writing, the spaces between its lines, its margins, binding, the carrying strap attached to it, or the bag or box it is in. However, it is allowed to carry a Qurān in baggage and to carry money, rings, or clothes on which Qurān is written

**The Forbidden Actions for a Person in the State of Major Impurity (in Need of Ritual Bath):**

1. Ṣalāh (prayer)
2. Ṭawāf (circumambulation of the ka’bah)
3. Touching or carrying the Qur’ān
4. Carrying the Qur’ān
5. Reciting the Qur’ān
6. To remain in the masjid

### **Relevant Forbidden Actions for a Person in the State of Menstruation:**

1. Ṣalāh (prayer)
2. Ṭawāf (circumambulation of the ka'bah)
3. Touching or carrying the Qur'ān
4. Carrying the Qur'ān
5. Reciting the Qur'ān
6. To remain in the masjid
7. Fasting
8. Divorce
9. To pass through a masjid for a woman who thinks her blood might soil the masjid
